

Student presentation on architectural design

Presenter: *Here is the location on the map [refers to slide] of the municipality we are working on which is VSG, which stands for Villeneuve-Saint-Georges. You can see that it's not far away from Paris, it's about 15 minutes away by train. You can also see that it is crossed by the Seine and by train tracks, and also by a main road called Av. N6.*

So the district that I'm working on especially is Triage. It is isolated from the rest of the municipality because of train tracks and the Seine. So, it has the size of a village, about 2000 inhabitants, who depend[s] on other cities, because, as you can see here [refers to slide], there is a lack of shops and services in the district, and this lack of shops forces the inhabitants to go to other city centres for the basic needs, such as food shopping or even healthcare. They mainly go to Choisy-Le-Roi or Villeneuve Saint Georges, but they could go to Villeneuve-Le-Roi which is only 300 metres away, but they never do because it takes 60 minutes, because they have to go all the way down to Villeneuve-Saint-Georges and take the Villeneuve-Le-Roi's bridge, which is crowded with traffic jams because of the big road named Av. N6.

So my project is to open Triage to Villeneuve-Le-Roi. So here you can see [refers to slide] that the new access includes the creation of a bus line, which brings closer the two city centres, and the two...train stations which belong to two different train lines, so this will offer new destinations for the inhabitants.
